The Rapid Access Haematology Clinic provides specialist diagnosis and management of acute haematological conditions including:

- New onset deep vein thrombosis
- Cytopenia(s) for investigation
- Lymphadenopathy for investigation
- Paraproteinaemia for investigation
- Investigation of possible bleeding/coagulation disorder

Patients are scheduled according to clinical urgency and contacted with appointment details.

Other acute referrals will be considered on receipt of referral. We will contact the GP if we are unable to review a referred patient. The clinic does not provide ongoing haematological care for chronic conditions.

Please only refer patients who are safe to be referred to a rapid access outpatient service. If there are any serious concerns, please refer them to the Emergency Department.
